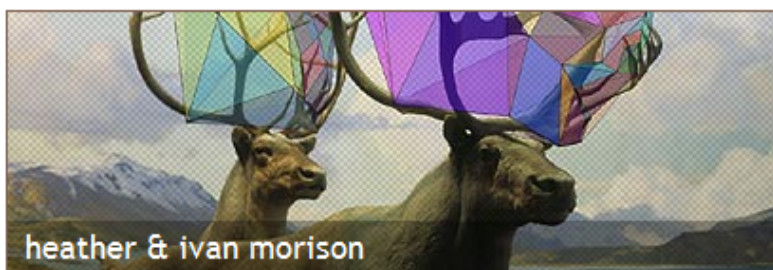

### Organic sci-fi at Danielle Arnaud.

Dr Who meets National Geographic. That's the only way to describe Heather and Ivan Morison's second show at the Danielle Arnaud gallery. Earthwalker is largely a photographic show backed with strange sci-fi sound installations that add an eerie atmosphere to the images, which at first could appear harmless.

In some still photos strange psychedelic-coloured geometric shapes seem to swirl out of organic natural environments. In two slide-show pieces raw nature is contrasted with rows of manmade flower farms. Nothing is quite explained, but there's a sense (heightened by the music) that the natural world is inviting, disturbing and changing.

The real star, though, is the South London Georgian town house which accommodates the Danielle Arnaud gallery; it brilliantly shows how artworks can be exhibited in a domestic space. They even use the garden to install a strange modernist beehive sculpture that looks like a surreal oversized kids' toy.

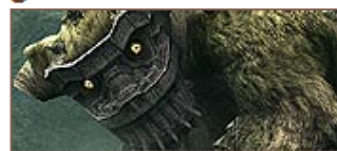
